Basic Idea: Recording artists can record "cover versions" of previously distributed songs

Section 114: No protection for sound-alikes

Text III

(Loud) DJ Skee featuring Charles Hamilton

Listen

P: Improvisational Jazz piece
P recorded version, but licensed rights to label for \$5000

Facts

D pays label \$1000 for right to sample SR
Only MW at issue in this case
District Court: SJ for D

Newton v. Diamond

Held

Reasoning

Listen

Three note combination riff at start of P's song that lasts four seconds "High-pitched whirling sound"

two-second sample

pitch lowered

D's sample

looped and extended to 16 beats 7 seconds

Appears 5 places in D's song

Facts

D got a license from MW owners

Same P owns MW and SR Who is Bridgeport Music?

Bridgeport Music v. Dimension Films

District Court

SJ for D
No reasonable juror would recognize the source of the sample

Held

"Released" blank CD-R

The Glee kids, having complied with the compulsory license rules, start selling their hit cover of Single Ladies. They sell millions

A local radio station begins to play the song over the air

They go on tour, and in the big encore, perform their cover of the song


Before the show, they play Beyonce's version of song from CD to the waiting crowd
